

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

*Admission is at the discretion of the Scottish Bluegrass Association Secretary subject to these conditions:*

1. Open fires are not permitted on any part of the festival site. Camping stoves and charcoal BBQ's are permitted; these must be kept clear of tents and cars and must not be left unattended.
2. Take all possible care to safeguard the health and safety of yourself and others.
3. Five mph vehicle speed limit on site. Car passes must be displayed on vehicles whilst on site.
4. Rowdy, unruly or drunken behaviour will not be tolerated. Police will deal with offenders.
5. Clear up all litter and waste material and remove to the skip provided.
6. Dogs must be kept on a lead.
7. The playing of amplified music, radios or stereos is strictly forbidden on site.
8. Wristbands must be worn on the wrist at all times. Wristbands and tickets must be shown to festival stewards on demand.
9. No camping on the main football pitch. Camp only in the designated area.
10. The festival campsite and facilities are available only from 12 noon on Friday through to 12 noon on Monday. No camping allowed outwith these times.
